Seven  $2\frac{1}{2}$ -hour, interactive and hands-on classes that meet once a week. Each session includes:


- Social time & skills review



# HOT DOCS Parenting Course

Negative behaviors such as whining and tantrums are very common during the toddler and preschool years (American Academy of Pediatrics, 2010). Healthy development, relationships, and school readiness may be compromised if these problems are not addressed successfully.

Caregivers may not know how to address these challenging behavior issues, and as a result, the cycle of frustration and stress continues. HOT DOCS offers a child and family-friendly approach to understanding children's needs and solving everyday behavior problems.

Over the course of 7 weeks, participants will learn to understand what causes behavior problems and how to implement realistic solutions that will foster their child's growth and development. HOT DOCS coaches will help each family design their own behavior plan, and provide plenty of support and encouragement along the way.

HOT DOCS is designed for parents, caregivers, and child service providers of children between the ages of birth and 5 years.

bocs for Success is an extension of the HOT DOCS curriculum designed to meet the unique needs of parents, caregivers, and providers of school-aged children between the ages of and 12 years.
